## Public Safety News from the:

### New Richland Emergency Departments



#### Recreational Fires



The only type of fire allowed during the spring and summer months in the City of New Richland is a recreational fire.

All fires must comply with the following regulations:

- Must be 25 feet from any structure or combustible material. Fire pits should also be constructed of non-combustible material. A fire ring or pit that is at least 8 inches deep is required.
- No burning is allowed on streets, sidewalks, or other public right of ways.
- Fires cannot exceed 3 feet in diameter.
- A fire extinguishing method needs to be present during the time of the fire. (i.e. garden hose, pail of water or sand)
- Someone must be in attendance of the fire at all times until extinguished.
- Only unpainted and untreated wood, coal or charcoal may be burned. **Absolutely NO garbage burning is allowed.**

**Please make sure your Sump Pumps are not discharging into the City's Sanitary Sewer System**

#### Grass Height & Clippings

Just a friendly reminder that Grass height should not exceed 6 inches in height and ALL lawn clippings need to be blown into your yards. No Grass Clippings May Go Into The Street. Please see the City Ordinance in Section 510 - Grass and Weeds 510.01 Height

#### City Compost Dump

The City Compost Dump and the end of South Broadway is to be used ONLY for Brush, Trees, Leaves, Grass Clippings and Garden Plants only. The City CANNOT accept cement, building materials, doors, windows, plastic, garbage, etc.



The dates to file for the Mayor and council positions for the city will be from 8 am July 28th thru Aug. 11th at 5 pm (filing needs to be done during the city hall business hours of 8-4:30 pm each day, except for the last day Aug. 11th you have until 5 pm)
